## Do You Know the Dodo?

1. Read about the dodo bird. Then underline the reason why it went extinct.

The dodo bird is the most famous extinct animal in the world. It lived on the island of Mauritius in the Indian Ocean. It was about one metre tall and weighed up to 17.5 kilograms. It ate fruits, but also stones to help it digest its food. The dodo bird couldn't fly.

No photographs of the dodo bird exist. People today know about the dodo from bones, drawings and paintings. That's because the dodo became extinct—it disappeared forever—in 1662. Some people say that European sailors killed all of the dodo birds because they were easy to hunt and eat. However, scientists say that the rats, cats and pigs that travelled with the Europeans were the real reason for the dodo's disappearance. These foreign animals snuck off the boats and onto the island, then ate the dodo eggs and baby birds.

Even though it has been gone for centuries, the dodo is a well-known bird! It appeared in the book *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* in 1865 and in the *Ice Age* movie series.
